This project aims to reduce pollinator exposure to pesticides, educate the public about harmful practices, and promote environmentally friendly alternatives. By collaborating with researchers, beekeepers, and farmers internationally, we aim to provide a powerful tool to guide concrete actions.

It requires the establishment of 10 study sites in 5 different countries.


